Restaurant unveils one of London's largest event spaces

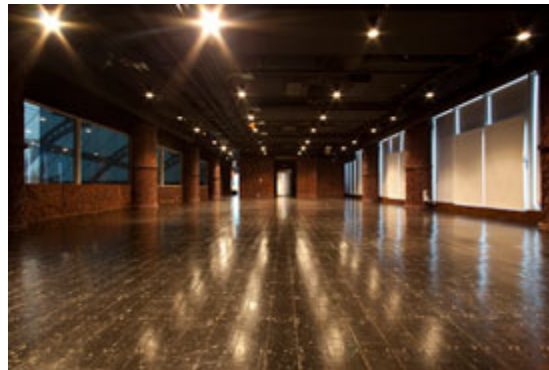
